## BRAILSFORD SPONSORED WALK 30th SEPT

Starting at 10am at Brailsford Church, a leisurely stroll takes you to Shirley Church, then onto Osmaston, Wyaston and finishing at Yeaveley. Refreshments will be available at all the checkpoints with hot or cold drinks on offer, cakes, biscuits and possibly sandwiches. You can go the whole distance of approximately 8 1/2 miles, or just do part of the walk, starting and stopping at any church along the way.
